



## APPRENTICESHIP


Cabinet makers use a variety of woods and laminates to construct and repair wooden cabinets, furniture, fixtures and related products.

Experienced workers who have not completed an Ontario apprenticeship but have equivalent qualifications or experience in their trade can use the <u>Trade</u> <u>Equivalency Assessment Process</u>.


## Highest Job Postings by Region

Certificates of Qualification Issued


by Age Group
