
Industrial Electricians install, maintain, test, troubleshoot and repair industrial electrical equipment and associated electrical and electronic controls.

Experienced workers who have not completed an Ontario apprenticeship but have equivalent qualifications or experience in their trade can use the [Trade Equivalency Assessment Process](#).

Required skills	Attention to detail, Innovation, Decision making, Problem solving



Highest Job Postings by Region





Job Postings by Area in Ontario






