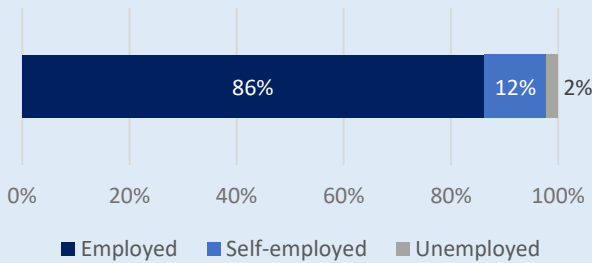


Motorcycle Technician (310G)

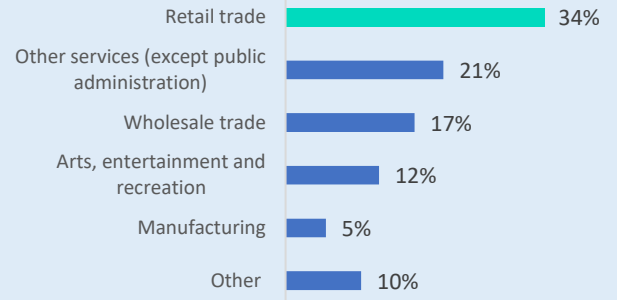

Ontario's Motorcycle Technician Workforce, 2022



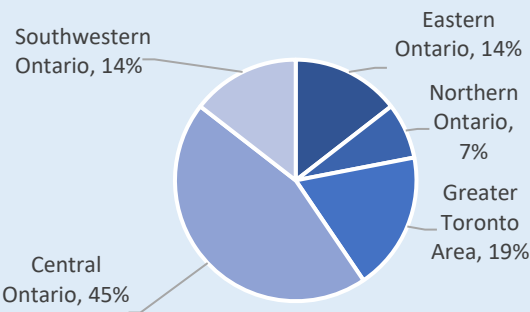

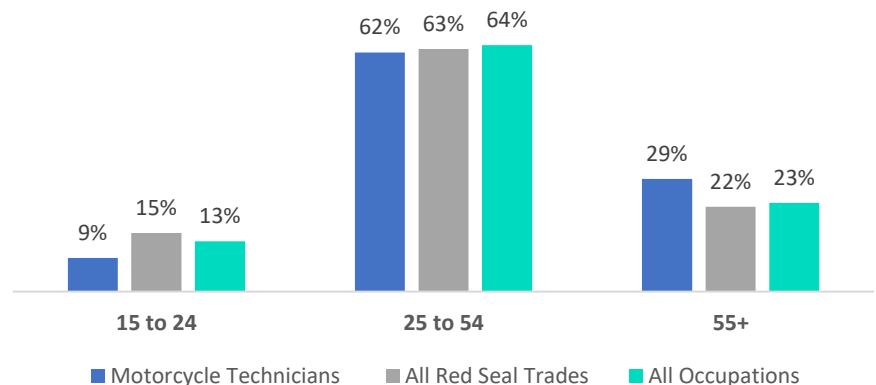

EDUCATION PATHWAY

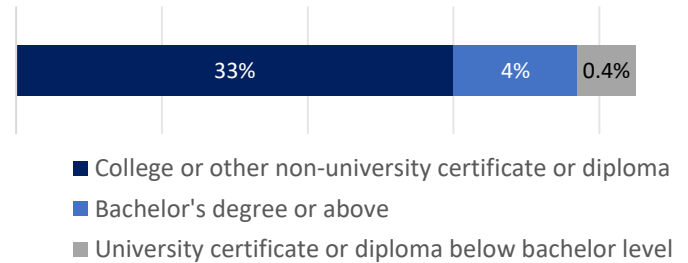
Motorcycle Technician is a compulsory trade in Ontario, requiring a Certification of Qualification, a Provisional Certificate of Qualification, or an active registered training agreement to practice within the province.

A grade 12 education is required to qualify for an apprenticeship.

The apprenticeship program is approximately three and a half years, consisting of 5,520 hours of on-the-job work experience and 2 levels of in-school training.
