

## Electrician-Domestic and Rural (309C) Exam Counselling Sheet

The Electrician – Domestic and Rural (309C) examination is based on the General Performance Objectives; the “Skill Sets” identified in the Training Standard Logbook for the trade. The Training Standard describes the skills and knowledge required to perform the duties of the trade. These standards and the examination were developed in consultation with representatives from the trade. The pass mark for the Ontario Certificate of Qualification exam is 70%.
